Safety Look



According to the Danish civilian rules for shooting training and competition, a Safety Look must be present in the weapon when you are not shooting. We have approx. 20 items in stock which are sold for 20 DKK each from the kiosk at the assembly area.

Competitors We have participation of 108 biathletes from Sweden, Germany, Belgium,

Finland, Great Britain, Czech Republic and Denmark. In addition to this, other orienteers will Saturday compete in a regular orienteering race - some of these

will also try the location-o course.
